Esta estructura tiene un orden diferente en inglés y es el siguiente:

1º . El (nombre del) poseedor acabado en 's .

2º . Lo que se posee (sin artículo delante).

ej. El coche de Peter

Peter's car

ej. El coche del médico

The doctor's car

- En singular se añade 's
 - My brother's book
 - John's car
- En plural se pone sólo el apóstrofe: '
 - My parents' house
 - The boys' names
- A los nombres propios que acaban en s sólo se le añade el apóstrofe: '
 - James' sister
 - Doris' father
